

Subject: Ho! Ho! Ho!

Game: Divide your students into 4 teams.

Team A:

Read: *No Rest for Bob Cratchit*

Find one synonym/one similar word to 10 words listed below e.g. start - beginning

Attention! Use English-English dictionary.

to arrive -

colourful -

eccentric -

business -

to celebrate -

to trail off -

job -

to recognize -

husband -

prominent -

Team B:

Read: *The Tree Takes Centre Stage*

Write 10 questions to the text.

Careful! The answers to those questions must be in the text.

e.g. Who wrote A Christmas Carol?

Team C:

Read: *Turkey Rules the Roost and Cards Take Off*

Use the glossary. Write English definitions of 10 words found in Turkey Rules the Roost and Cards Take Off.

Team D:

Read: *What About the Pressies?*

Draw 10 illustrations to the vocabulary found in *What about the Pressies?*

e.g. an almond, Christmas crackers

Each group presents the results of their work to the rest of the students.

Team A presents the vocabulary.

Team B asks the questions. Other students have to answer.

Team C reads the definitions. Other students need to find the words defined in the text.

Team D shows the illustrations. Others try to guess what is presented in the pictures.

Homework:

Find 10 symbols typical of a Polish Christmas. Be able to explain orally why you consider those 10 things to be typical of a Polish Christmas.
